

Cyclife is strengthening its development in Germany with the acquisition of Balcke Dürr Nuklear Service GmbH

Cyclife, the EDF subsidiary in charge of dismantling and waste management international services, is pursuing its expansion in Europe by acquiring complementary capacities provided by Balcke Dürr Nuklear Service GmbH.

Following successful projects and the creation of Cyclife Germany in 2021, Cyclife has decided to acquire Balcke-Dürr Nuklear Service GmbH. Cyclife Germany will take over 100% of the shares in the company previously held by Balcke-Dürr GmbH (NEM Energy Group / Mutares SE & Co), with effect from 1 June 2024. This company proposes a broad range of services in the field of dismantling and waste management: characterisation of facilities, dismantling operations (cutting, complex handling, etc.), clearance, waste management and radiation protection... which will complement the projects developed by Cyclife Germany to provide to the European market a complete and integrated offering, from the initial stages of dismantling to waste management solutions.

"Cyclife Germany GmbH created in December 2021 was the first step to consolidate our presence in Germany, following some successful business and projects such as the PreussenElektra Steam Generator fleet contract and our long-lasting history of waste treatment for all German operators and partners. The integration of new competencies from Balcke-Dürr Nuklear Service allows Cyclife to broaden its range of skills and strengthens its ability to provide integrated dismantling and waste solutions with high added value."
